

Components of a Multi-Component Physical Education Policy

- 1. State <u>does not</u> permit school districts or schools to allow students to substitute other activities for their required physical education credit
- 2. State <u>does not</u> grant exemptions/waivers for school districts regarding physical education time or credit requirements
- 3. State has its own standards for physical education
- State requires all who teach <u>elementary school</u> physical education to be certified/licensed
- State requires all who teach <u>middle/junior high school</u> physical education to be certified/licensed
- State requires all who teach <u>high school</u> physical education to be certified/licensed
- 7. State mandates elementary school physical education
- 8. State mandates <u>middle/junior high school</u> physical education
- 9. State mandates high school physical education
- 10.State requires professional development/continuing education to maintain/renew physical education teacher certification/licensure
